Unveiling AI and Machine Learning: Critical thinking discourses in mathematics education

> Christian Andersson Malmö University, Sweden

ABSTRACT

Al and machine learning are becoming increasingly important technologies in society. In the context of the internet, most of us experience daily, the output of predictive algorithms that take our digital footprints as data. However, mathematical models are not necessarily objective or politically neutral, as model assumptions may portray stereotypes, and algorithmic bias may operate as oppression for unprivileged groups in society. The topic of this dissertation project aims to investigate what discourses are enacted when mathematics education begins to encompass critical thinking on societal perspectives in relation to online algorithms. Tentative results will be presented.

Open source may make LLMs more Accessible

Artificial intelligence developers are using open-source principles to rectify biases and to make large language models smaller, less resource- and dataintensive, and thus more widely available. Some have succeeded in shrinking LLaMA even further, including by reducing the precision of parameters as well as the number of parameters, but some experts warn that making LLMs open source is risky.



Biden, AI Experts Discuss Federal Role in Regulating AI

A group of artificial intelligence experts met with President Joe Biden in San Francisco to discuss the opportunities and risks presented by AI and consider how the federal government can prevent harm without stifling innovation. In remarks prior to the closed-door meeting, Biden cited social media as an example of how powerful technology can cause harm in the absence of safeguards.
